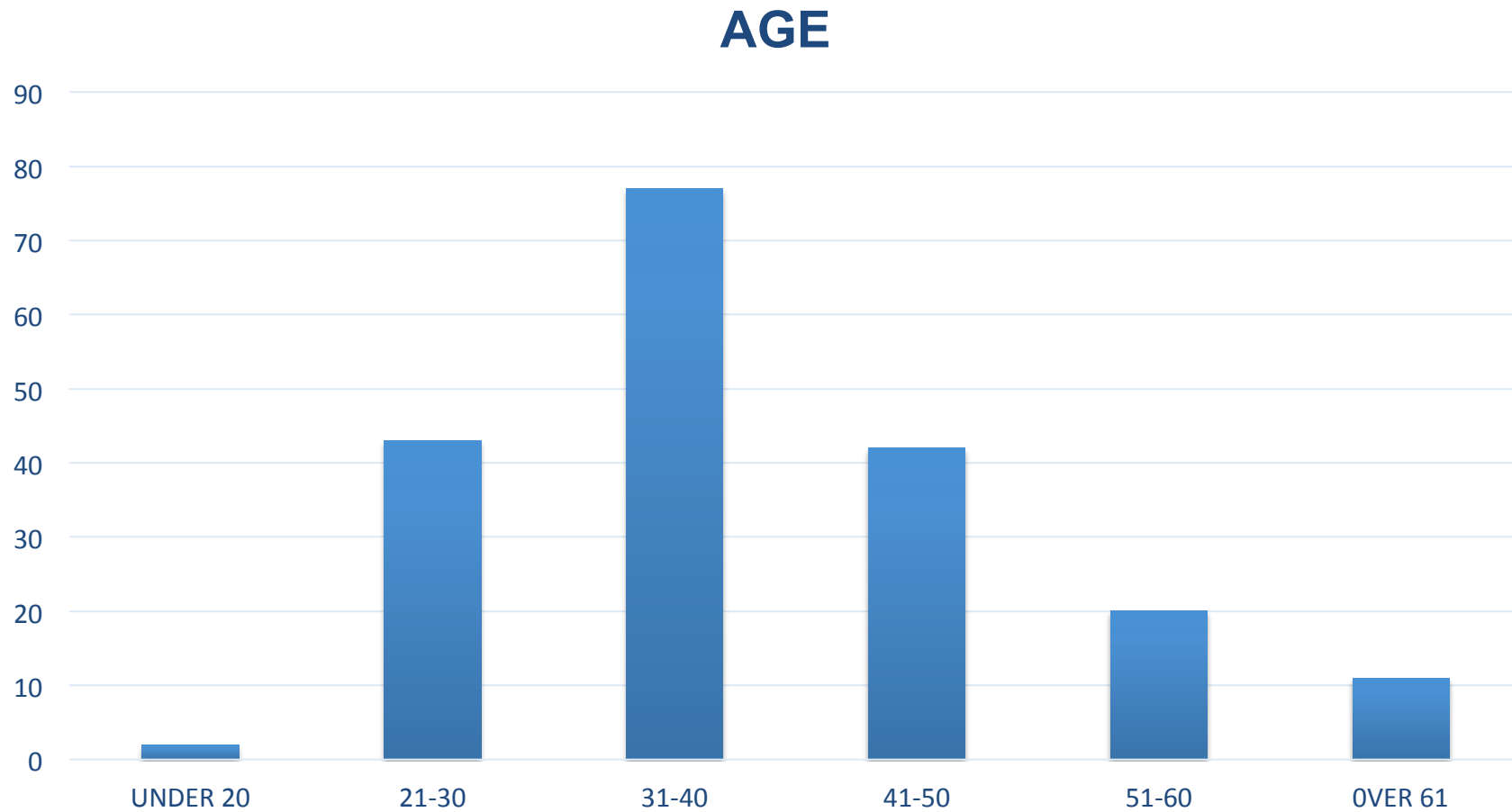
MENTAL HEALTH NURSE ROLE

- MORE APPROPRIATE REFERRALS
- INCREASE STAFF KNOWLEDGE AND SUPPORT

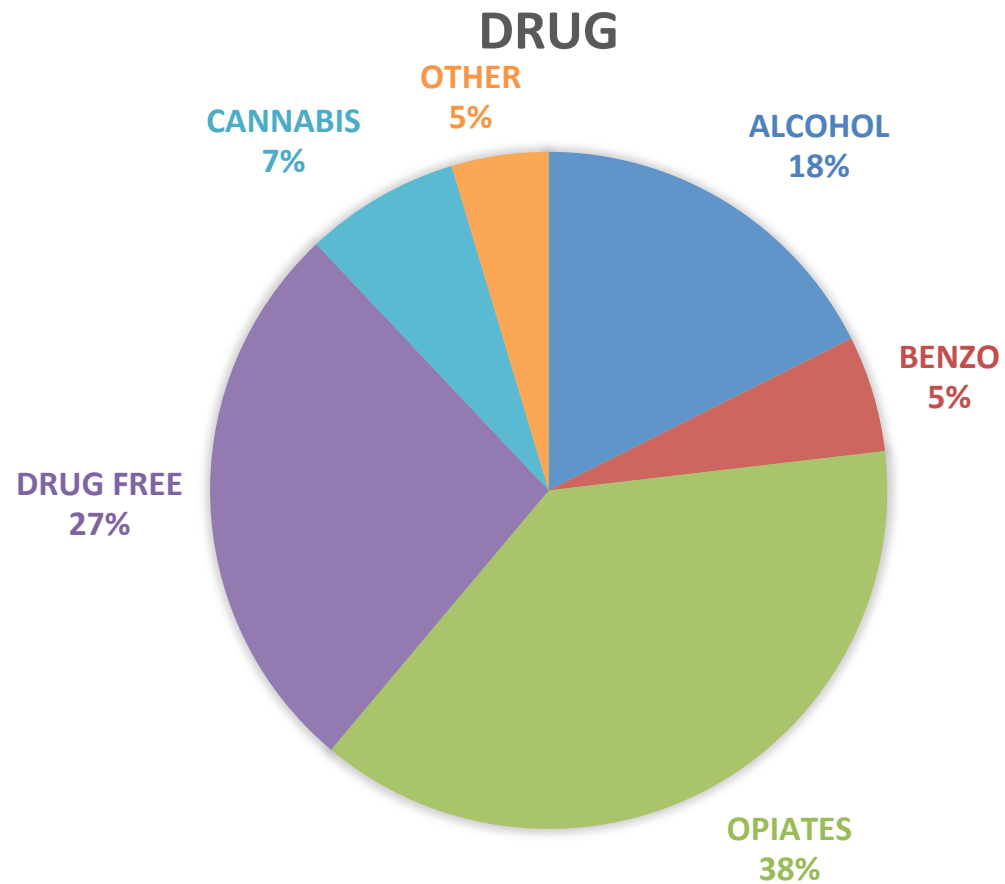
ENGAGEMENT IN 2014

- 195 CLIENTS ASSESSED
- 144 MALE – 74%
- 51 FEMALE - 26%
- 160 IRISH – 82%
- 35 FOREIGN NATIONALS – 18%
- 123 REPORTED A MENTAL HEALTH DIAGNOSIS – 63%

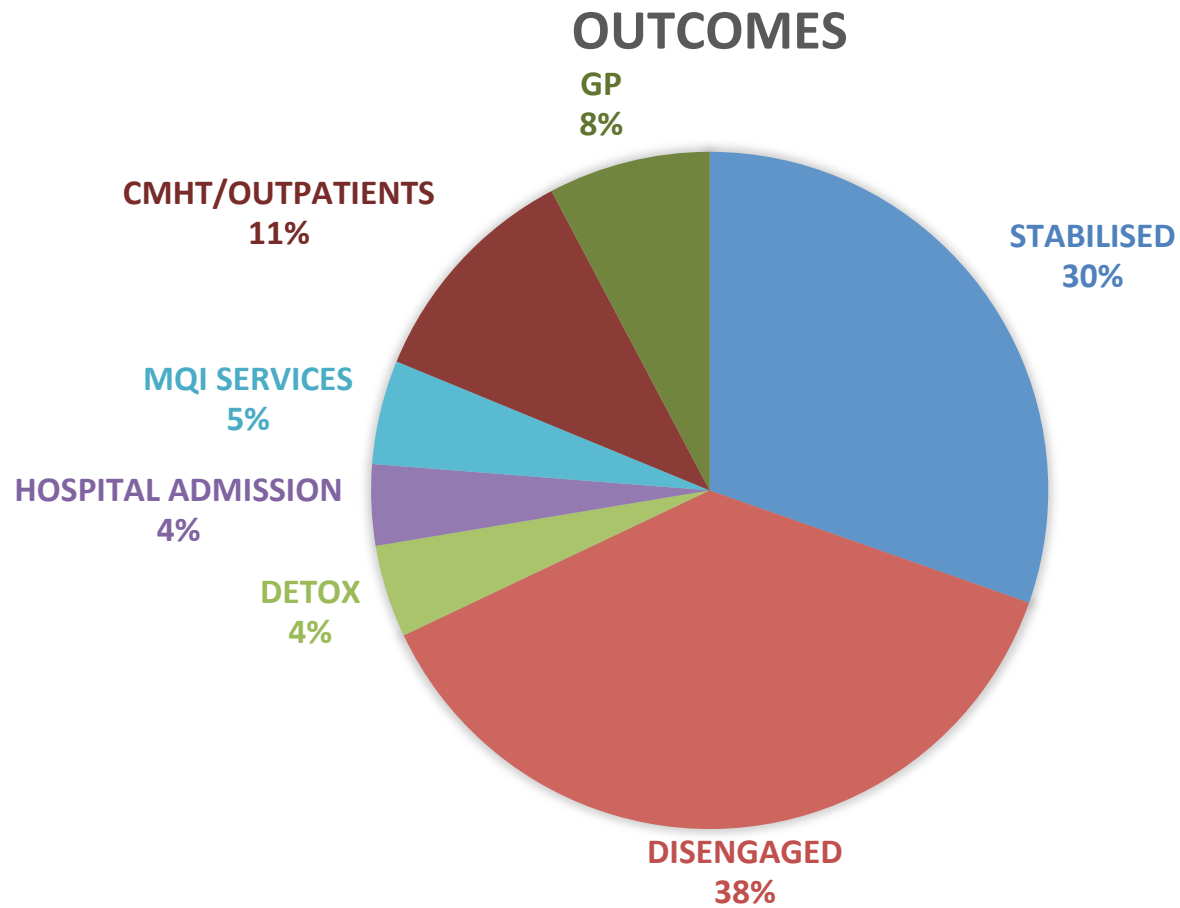
AGE BREAKDOWN

ENGAGEMENT 2015-SO FAR

- 121 CLIENTS ASSESSED
- 87 MALE – 72%
- 34 FEMALE – 28%
- 102 IRISH – 84%
- 19 FOREIGN NATIONALS – 16%
- 70 REPORTED MENTAL HEALTH DIAGNOSIS-
57%

- JAMES , 42 YEAR OLD MAN FROM SCOTLAND
- DIAGNOSED SCHIZOAFFECTIVE DISORDER
- HAZARDOUS DRINKER
- PRESCRIBED ORAL AND DEPOT MEDICATION
- NUMEROUS INSTANCES OF ABSCONSION
- ALWAYS IMPRISONED OR DETAINED
